Unit 6 – Firefighting 2

- Nine of the thirteen candidates passed this years paper
- The average mark for those who passed was 71% and the overall average mark for all candidates was 64%.
- Only 4 candidates attempted Question One which could reflect that the purpose of an operational review is not well understood or known.
- Question Three (Part A) showed that a significant number of candidates did not understand the occasions when oxygen therapy should be administered to patients. As this is a relatively new procedure for many brigades it is hoped that this will improve in the future.
- Question Five on decontamination procedures was not well answered and over half of the candidates scored less than a required pass for this question.
- Three candidates scored perfect marks in two of the questions.
