Question 1:

Top score: 9

Bottom score: 6

Average score: 7

4 out of 4 candidates answered this question

Candidates demonstrated a poor understanding of the Protected Disclosure policy and the processes involved in making protected disclosures.

Question 2:

Top score: 14

Bottom score: 9

Average score: 11.75

4 out of 4 candidates answered this question

Overall a pass mark was achieved by the majority of candidates who attempted this question. Most marks were lost from candidates not knowing the items to be included in all oral and written warnings.

Question 3:

Top score: 12

Bottom score: 9

Average score: 10.3

3 out of 4 candidates answered this question

Most candidates appeared to have guessed the answers to this question with poor results. The entire syllabus needs to be read if candidates wish to receive good marks.

Question 4:

Top score: 11

Bottom score: 6

Average score: 8.8

4 out of 4 candidates answered this question

Variations of this topic have been used over the past few years so candidates should have been able to demonstrate a better understanding of the IT policy.

Question 5:

Top score: 10

Bottom score: 10

Average score: 10

1 out of 4 candidates answered this question

An unpopular question with only one candidate attempting Fire Protection Agreements.

Question 6:

Top score: 18

Bottom score: 12

Average score: 14.5

4 out of 4 candidates answered this question

This was a popular question and overall was well answered. Candidates should read the question to determine what is being asked for and ensure they have read the required reading prior to sitting the examination.
