Unit 9 – Legislation

Question 1:

Most candidates failed to understand the question and gave examples that were irrelevant to the Fires Service and got horribly confused between each question. They also failed to give the main point asked of them. Acts are constituted by Parliament, Regulation by department heads, Bylaws local authorities, codes of practice by an organisation but were not forcible.

Question 2:

All but two candidates had a very good knowledge of this piece of legislation.

Question 3:

The least favoured question, however those candidates who attempted the question answered it very well.

Question 4:

Three candidates had a very knowledge of the question, one scored a perfect score, whilst two others had virtually no knowledge of the question.

Question 5:

The best answered question. Most had a very good understanding of the question. Some confusion about the speed through an intersection controlled by traffic signals.

Question 6:

Most candidates lost points on principle 3 of the Privacy Act.
