Rule 9.16: The United Fire Brigades' Associations Valour Medal may be awarded to any member of a Fire Brigade which is a member of the Association at the time, who exhibits exceptional personal courage saving or attempting to save human life and may have placed his or her own life in danger at any fire, emergency or other fire brigade operation.

- (a) Details of the incident are to be recorded on the proper form, signed by the Officer in Charge of the brigade and forwarded together with any additional information to the General Manager of the Association within six months of the occurrence.
- (b) Nominees having received or who are likely to receive some other award for the same incident will not be precluded from applying for or receiving the Valour Medal.
- (c) The Medal will be presented by the President to the recipient at the Annual Conference of the Association. In exceptional circumstances the Executive may allow the Medal to be presented at some other suitable function or venue.
