

UFBA Waterway Rule Clarifications 2022 – 2023

Note clarifications below indicated in Red

1. F11 & F12 – Hydrant with Forestry Hose 29th Nov 2022

Inadvertently we have left the word **preset** about the Forestry Branch in the run description which was not our intention. It was agreed by all that we will use the General Conditions and define as all branches will be set in the Shut Position.

Events F11 + F12 the branch will be set by the official screwed to the Off Position, which will not be allowed to changed prior the start by the teams.

2. F9 – Hydrant with Hose 24th Jan 2023

Any flake hose used in this event needs to be the same size as the Flake Tray designed for the delivery locker of the appliance that is assigned to the Flat & Open Water Track.

3. F13 & F14 – Changeover 24th Jan 2023

This event has two evolutions in it. Once the first target is struck, the appliance rev's (if used) must be returned to idle immediately, otherwise Penalty 5 will apply.

4. A3 & A4 – Ground Monitor 24th Jan 2023

At the completion of the run the monitor and delivery valve are to remain open and flowing to allow the officials to inspect the delivery at the 32 and 40 metre marks.

5. Refer to Team Requirements – Team Uniform – Bullet Point 2 – Page 5 24th Jan 2023

The approved uniform will consist of full-length shirt sleeves and full-length trousers or FENZ approved Level One equivalent. Sleeves will not be rolled up nor will they be taped up at the cuff. Trousers may be tucked into the socks and no tape is to be used above knee height. (This excludes skins or lycra styled clothing)

6. Refer to Team Requirements – Sponsorship – Page 5 24th Jan 2023

Sponsorship is not to be displayed on any clothing within the confines of the competing area. (This includes helmets)

7. Refer to Officials – Referees – Bullet Point 4 – Page 7 (Team Captains Mark) 4th Feb 2023

Collect the score card from the Time Keeper, sign all cards and record the appropriate penalties (Field Secretary to total event time). Explain penalties to Team Captain and ensure the Team Captain signs the card.

The Team Captain is required to report at the completion of the run, to the mark which has been identified on the Track with the letters "TC" sprayed. This mark is generally between the Start Line and the Time Keepers Tent.
