

COVID-19 Response Risk Management

Objective

The UFBA will uphold a culture of compliance to reduce COVID-19 related risk to events through leadership, influence, and education to ensure best practice. At all times this should be taken into account as well as the Covid Protection Framework.

Under what level can UFBA Challenges go ahead?

The UFBA can deliver all challenge events within Government guidelines under **Orange** or **Green** levels. However Challenge events are unable to go ahead under the **Red** level or local lockdowns.

UFBA Challenge attendees

- The NZ Government Covid Protection Framework requires anyone that attends a UFBA challenge (including officials, competitors, contractors, sub-contractors, and supporters) must produce a valid My Vaccine Pass at the event.
- All attendees must use the QR codes for the NZ COVID Tracer app, or sign in manually.
- All attendees exercise general hygiene etiquette such as sneezing and coughing into elbow, regular hand washing and hand sanitising.
- Where possible, maintain physical distancing as per Government guidelines.
- Competitors and Officials must stay at home if feeling unwell and contact Healthline (0800 611 116) or their GP to determine if a COVID-19 test is needed.

UFBA Commitment to Covid Response

- Build a registration database of all competitors and officials attending each event for tracking purposes.
- Scan and confirm all attendees My Vaccine Pass upon entry at an event
- Clearly display a QR code from the Ministry of Health for attendee tracking.
- Optional physical attendee log at registration desk for those who do not use smart phones.
- Uphold best hygiene practice in line with current government guidelines.
- Provide visible Ministry of Health signage with clear COVID-19 hygiene instructions.
- Provide hand washing facilities where available otherwise provide hand sanitizer for all attendees.
- Ensuring regular wipe down of common surfaces and equipment.
- Ensuring FENZ policies are upheld regarding BA cleaning
- Manage all contractors and sub-contractors and ensure they all have their My Vaccine Pass and uphold best hygiene practices
- Incorporate COVID-19 requirements in all safety briefings to officials.
- Include COVID-19 protocol in the final information email sent to all attendees one week prior to each event.
- Complying with many and varied venue restrictions around the country that has dictated our decision to only allow competitors and officials to attend UFBA prizegiving's under the current framework.
