

Personal Tool Belt & Extra Equipment

If further clarification is required, it will be addressed at the Chief Assessors briefing to all Teams.

Tool Belts

These are the only allowable items in toolbelts or on person that are being brought into pits by challenge team members.

This ruling has come about from excessive tools being carried by team members potentially giving advantage to teams while competing.

(These items are over and above standard pit rescue equipment tools supplied, challenge rules still apply for like for like swap outs)

List:

Tool	Quantity
Screwdriver (maximum blade length 250mm) or trim/rubber removal tools	2
Rubber Mallet	1
Pliers or Vice Grips	1
Side Cutters	1
Tape Measure & Marker Pen	1
Seat Belt Cutter	1
Small Pry bar (max length 250mm)	1
Glass Breaking Tool	1
Snips or Industrial Scissors	1
Small Torch or Helmet torch	1
Box Cutter/Knife	1

No other tools will be permitted – Assessors will be monitoring equipment and will have final say.

Medical Equipment

All medical equipment that is over and above the challenge rules pit list or gives advantage to competing teams will need to be produced at the Assessor briefing for scrutineering. Teams bringing in extra equipment that has not been scrutinised will need approval from the Medical and Command Assessor in that pit.

If it is deemed to be giving an advantage it will not be able to be used. Assessors will be monitoring equipment and will have final say.
