Please carefully read the information below regarding the different registration types and funding information.

DELEGATES

Each member brigade shall be entitled to have one delegate, who must attend and vote at the AGM, and participate in the one and a half days of Conference Hui. A delegate must be an enrolled member who has been elected at a regular or scheduled meeting of the Enrolled Members of the Voting Member (refer UFBA Constitution rule 6.10 (a & b). They must fill out the included AGM Delegate Nomination Form and send to the UFBA Events Team before registrations close.

ADDITIONAL DELEGATE (FORMERLY OBSERVER)

Additional members of your brigade may attend. These additional delegates do not have delegate voting rights or speaking rights at the AGM and attend at their own cost. We strongly advise considering this as a succession plan for your brigade.

PAST PRESIDENTS AND LIFE HONORARY MEMBERS

Please select Past President or Life Honorary Member at the start of your registration, then select whether you will be a voting or non-voting delegate. You will be assigned accommodation and travel for your appropriate registration type. Separate communication outlining your entitlements will be sent to you directly.

PARTNERS

Partners of firefighters are an important and greatly appreciated part of the brigade family, fully immersed in the social activities and the greatest support for the firefighters themselves. This year, a small group of partners are offering an opportunity for partners to meet and mix together while the conference is in session. This will include user-pay network time on Friday afternoon, with the opportunity to arrange activities and tag along with others over the Saturday or just to catch up. If your partner is interested in participating, you will be able to include this information in your own online registration.

VOTING IS AN ESSENTIAL PART OF YOUR INVOLVEMENT

Every voting Delegate, Past President and Life Honorary Member has the right to discuss matters and have their brigade's opinion heard at UFBA's AGM. This is your opportunity to let us know what you want.

Every voting delegate can vote on behalf of their brigade on important decisions made at the AGM. Make sure you are familiar with the voting process so you can fully participate.

WHAT YOU ARE VOTING FOR THIS YEAR

UFBA Members: You will be given the opportunity to vote for your next **Vice President**

There will also be an opportunity for you to vote on motions that will be submitted by other member brigades and the board. These are important to help the UFBA be better representatives for you going forward. Information on what you are voting on will be sent to your brigade one month prior to the AGM. So you have time to discuss at your brigade meeting and decide how your brigade would like to vote. **Remember that you are representing your entire brigade.**

UFBA SECONDED MOTIONS

Seconded motions must be received by the CE by **23 July 2026**. The form to submit a motion is available on the UFBA website.

UFBA VICE PRESIDENT NOMINATIONS

Nominations for the UFBA Vice President will close on **23 August 2026**. The nomination form is available on the UFBA website.

CAN'T MAKE IT THIS YEAR? USE A PROXY

Did you know that if your brigade can't send a Delegate to the AGM, you can ask a neighbouring brigade that is attending to vote on your behalf? Alternatively you can offer to be a proxy for a local brigade with a signed permission form. We'll send out more information about the voting process nearer the time.

IMPORTANT FUNDING INFORMATION

UFBA will be funding AGM delegates for Friday. Fire and Emergency are funding Delegates for the Conference Hui on Saturday and Sunday. Delegates who are funded are required to attend all events. If you do not attend your selected events, you will be invoiced for all associated costs including, but not limited to, ticketed flights, booked accommodation, and catering. Lateness and early departure before the close of the AGM or Conference Hui will be not tolerated unless there are extenuating circumstances, and you have permission from the Chair of the Board.

DAVE (BUTTABEAN) LETELE

LANCE BURDETT

With 22 years of policing experience at the highest level, Lance has emergencies and communicating in challenging situations. In his 13 years as a crisis negotiator for the NZ Police, Lance specialised in suicide intervention and on predicting violent behaviour.



Lance's resiliency programme was adopted by the 111 Emergency Call Centre nationally and formed part of the mandatory training for all Police call centre staff. This led to the founding of WARN International, assisting organisations to mitigate the effects of stress on their employees by enhancing communication skills, managing their safety & security, and by providing personal resilience coaching.

Lance has been well-received by our membership over the years, consistently rating in the top list of speakers.

TRAVEL

BY AIR

If you are eligible for flights, you will be asked to confirm your preferred flight when you register online. An email will be sent to you with your flight option which you will need to respond to within 24 hours to confirm. When this process is complete you will receive your confirmed itinerary once rooms are allocated. If you do not receive your itinerary you must contact Gilpin Travel immediately. Once these flights are booked they are non-transferable and non-refundable.

We strongly advise booking your travel through Gilpin. They can also book partners flights at your own cost. Please make note of this in your online registration. If you book flights through another provider, you must notify the UFBA Events Team well in advance of your travel arrangements to ensure that you are on our transfer lists.

BY ROAD

If you are driving, you are entitled to a return mileage reimbursement which is calculated from the centre of your town to the centre of Auckland. Refer to Google Maps.

If you choose to drive but flying is more cost effective, you will only be reimbursed the equivalent of a seat plus bag fare.

Hotel parking is limited in Auckland, and may be reimbursed up to \$25.00 per day. Pre-booking parking and car sharing is recommended. Please ensure you include your GST receipt with your expense claim.

OTHER

You can arrange your own alternate form of transport if you wish. Please note, the UFBA will reimburse the most cost effective method of travel regardless of how you choose to get to Conference Hui.

TRANSFERS

Airport transfers will be automatically arranged for those booking through Gilpin Travel and who are travelling on the recommended dates. Those travelling outside of these dates must make their own transport arrangements.

The breakfasts and the Saturday dinner are at NZICC and transfers are not required for those staying in UFBA provided accommodation. Please note that transport to and from locations outside those organised by the UFBA will not be provided.

The transfer schedule will be sent to you in the Final Information email one week prior to the UFBA Conference Hui date. Please ensure you register online with an email address that you check regularly.

ACCOMMODATION

FUNDED ACCOMMODATION FOR NOMINATED DELEGATES

We have many accommodation providers for Delegates in Auckland this year. These rooms are held in a bulk booking which can only be accessed when you register online.

WHAT YOU ARE ENTITLED TO:

If you live more than 25km away from the Conference Hui venue: Two nights of funded accommodation at the UFBA selected accommodation properties. If you require additional accommodation, a formal written request should be submitted to the UFBA Events Team for approval. Applications will be considered on a case by case basis.

If you live within 25km of the Conference Hui venue:

Accommodation is not funded. You will have the option of booking at the UFBA-selected accommodation properties on a self-funded basis.

Gilpin Travel will allocate rooms for delegates and funded guests based on requirements, entitlements as above and arrival times.

IMPORTANT NOTE: If you intend to twin share your accommodation, please book one room for the FUNDED traveller and note who you would like to share with. When the second person registers, please select 'no accommodation required' but note who you would like to share with. Ensure that your coperson has agreed to share.

FUNCTIONS & MEALS

All lunch and tea breaks throughout the UFBA Conference Hui are provided for all registered participants.

FOR DELEGATES

If you are funded to have Thursday night accommodation, one breakfast for **Friday only** is charged back to your hotel room and will be paid for by the UFBA (excluding room service delivery charges). **Saturday and Sunday** breakfasts will be catered for at NZICC. Any other costs must be settled at the hotel upon checkout.

Friday night is a free night, funded delegates can spend up to \$50 inc. GST and arrange their own meal. Please keep your GST receipt for your expense claim.

All other additional meals are at your own cost, i.e. partners' breakfasts.

The UFBA Dinner ticket for Saturday night is to be selected at the time of registration. Partners are an additional cost. The UFBA does not cover the cost of beverages. There will be a bar available which is cashless and **EFTPOS only**.
